Race Syracuse's Tour in All its Glory ***Syracuse Race Weekend is Just Around the Corner***

SYRACUSE— Pull out your bicycle or, just simply, the spectator lawn chair; we're less than a month away from the **14th Annual Syracuse Race Weekend!** With the help of the Maxpowercycling.com racing team, the Onondaga Cycling Club puts on the **three-event, two-day stage race** attracting top competitors from across the Northeast. So, mark your calendars for May 17th – 18th: the dates of this exciting and family-fun-filled cycling competition.

Starting 14 years ago, Syracuse Race Weekend is now one of the Northeast's premier bicycle races. This year's competition consists of three events: a road race, a time trial, and a criterium. New this year is a full time trail, occurring Song Mountain, and a criterium located at Syracuse's Inner Harbor.

Last years race drew over 300 cyclists and treated hundreds of spectators to a fantastic caliber of athletes that included professional and amateur racers from around the Northeast, Canada and beyond. Some of these athletes included:

Event Details

Saturday, May 17th: *Two events at Song Mountain*

- 1.) The road race – starting at 10 AM, competitors do battle over distances of 33 to 87 miles while racing from Song Mountain through Otisco Valley and up the fearsome Oak Hill Rd. climb
- 2) The Time Trial – starting 3:30 PM, cyclists individually compete against the clock while racing a 6.5 mile course.

Sunday, May 18th: *Syracuse Criterium at the Inner Harbor*

Some call it NASCAR on two wheels; no wonder why it's such a spectator-friendly event! For the uninitiated, the Criterium is a high energy race where competitors pass within inches of one another while racing a circuit. This year's race starts at 9 AM at Syracuse's Inner Harbor.

At **12pm** there is a **FREE Kids Race** for children ages 2 to 14. All children who participate will receive a ribbon. This is a great time to take a break from the adult competition and enjoy this family-friendly event. The Kids Race is also an excellent opportunity for the children to grab a **Free helmet** and helmet fitting provided by Packet TV (www.packettv.com).

So spend a sunny Sunday afternoon with the family at the Inner Harbor where there will be excitement, music and food.
