Harley Riders Spend Night in Syracuse

SYRACUSE, NY- Imagine the roar of hundreds of Harley-Davidson motorcycles rolling into Syracuse from all points north, east and south in New York State. You can experience just that on the evening of **Wednesday, July 9**. Members of the Harley Owners Group, HOG® will converge on the city, and spend the night, en route to the New York State HOG rally in Niagara Falls.

Riders will begin in Plattsburgh, Albany and New Rochelle earlier in the day. Additional riders will join along the way. All are expected to arrive at Performance Harley-Davidson, 807 North Geddes Street, between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. From there, most out-of-town riders will leave for the Wingate Inn on Walters Road, town of Van Buren, to check-in for their night's stay.

Riders will leave the Wingate, en masse, at 5:30 p.m. for a group ride back to a party at Performance Harley-Davidson. The group will enter I-690 at State Fair Boulevard and exit at Route 298/Bear Street, proceeding south on Spencer Street to Geddes Street.

At Performance, they will join the crowd for the regular Wednesday "Bike Night" festivities. This will include live blues music provided by Phil Petroff and the Natural Fact. There will also be food and beverages available for purchase from caterers from the Limp Lizard Lounge. The local Harley dealership will be open until 9:00 p.m. and have a number of in-store specials. Various contests and raffles will take place outside at the party venue.

Bikers will again gather at Performance H-D on Thursday, July 10, and leave from there for points west at 9:00 a.m.
