**Renowned Horses Compete in Syracuse at the
Empire State Arabian Spring Horse Show
May 2 – 4**

SYRACUSE, NEW YORK—Come watch horses from all over the Northeast, Atlantic Coast, Ohio and Canada compete at the Empire State Arabian Spring Horse Show, happening from **Friday, May 2nd thru Sunday, May 4th** in the Coca Cola Coliseum at the New York State Fairgrounds. There is no cost for this event; both the horse show and parking are **free** to the public.

Over 200 Arabian horses will be competing in a variety of events; including English, Western and Hunter classes. The winners will be awarded cash prizes and/or trophies, and members of the public are invited to view and cheer on their favorite horse in competition. There are classes for everyone from two years old to ninety. Classes start each day at 8:00am with three sessions on Friday and Saturday and two on Sunday ending at about 4:00pm.

The winners of the Empire State Arabian Spring Horse Show will qualify to compete in the Regional 16 Arabian Horse Championship, being held back on the fairgrounds in July 2008.

Syracuse has a long history of hosting horse shows at the New York State Fairgrounds dating back to 1840. The shows make up some of the largest equestrian events in the Northeastern United States. This show marks the 3rd show in a series of horse shows at the fair during the spring, summer, and fall.
